The Walking Bus will then proceed along Kent Street picking up children (whom we call "passengers", identified by their impeccable behaviour) along the way.

In the afternoons children depart from the OLD SHELTER SHED at 1540 accompanied by two drivers, who will deposit children with a waiting Responsible Adult along Kent St, terminating at TUNBRIDGE ST about 1600. (Note: The progeny of tardy R.A.'s will always be accommodated, refer to contact numbers below)
