## FLEMINGTON PRIMARY SCHOOL 2017 Essential Student Learning Items, Bookpack, Levies & Voluntary Contribution

### ESSENTIAL STUDENT LEARNING ITEMS

These are items, activities or services that are essential to support student learning of the standard curriculum and that the school considers essential for all students and which students take possession of. Parents may choose to provide items themselves or buy items from the school where practical and appropriate.

### EXCURSIONS & INCURSIONS LEVY

***An Excursion and Incursion Levy applies to all students. This levy is \$75 per child.***

This levy is non-refundable as activities are planned on full attendance. The sum is based on the average cost of excursions / incursions over the last few years.

This Levy meets all costs of the year. Payment of this as a lump sum significantly reduces teacher and office workload and reduces parent stress in finding exact amounts for these activities. Where it is difficult for parents to pay the full amount immediately, Term payments can be made.

This Levy **does not** include Instrumental Music Fees, Camps, Whole School Swimming program (Foundation-6), Grade 5 & 6 AVDSSA Sports or Extension Programs.

### SCHOOL SPORTS LEVY (For Grades 5 & 6 students)

This levy covers the affiliation to the District Sports Association plus the cost of buses during Terms 1 & 4 to transport children to and from matches. It also covers the cost for sports education and coaching clinics that are run for those students who are not selected for the interschool sports teams.

This levy does not cover cost of transport to the Athletics, Swimming or Cross Country Carnivals.

This levy does not include the swimming program.

### OPTIONAL ITEMS (For Grades 6 students)

The grade 6 students have the option to purchase a commemorative hoodie and polo. The students are sized in November in the year prior to commencing grade 6 and the tops are delivered in readiness for when they start their grade 6 year.

### VOLUNTARY FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS

**Grounds** – This contribution is to assist the school in enhancing the grounds in terms of maintenance and beautification (oval, garden beds, paths, mulch etc).

**Building Fund and Library** - The school has for many years held Australian Taxation Department approval for tax deductible Building Fund and Library. Contribution to either is fully tax deductible and, for many families on or near the top marginal tax rate, this is a very effective way of assisting the school.
