- Some families do not use any technologies.


FPS Communication Platforms

- Communicates reminders and whole school information to families

- A way for parents and teachers to communicate more formal information, such as academic progress, etc




- Email via the school office – flemington.ps@education.vic.gov.au
- Class Dojo
- Phone via the school office
- In person

- If a teacher can not speak to you, they will make a mutually convenient time.
- Please note that teachers do not answer their classroom phones or check messages on Dojo when they are teaching.
- Teachers will respond to your messages in working hours and can take up to 48 hours.
- Teachers are not expected to respond to messages late at night, on weekends or during school holidays.




